All items include a cleaning and restoration to good condition unless stated otherwise. I am happy to give you a frank account of each and more information on each design.

Packing and shipping costs are additional.

## Oversized Table Lamps - circa 1995

Solid Cherry, Enameled Steel, Handmade Shades  
On/off turn switches. Long black cords.

Heights: 48" and 35"

Condition: good, used condition

(There is one small dent on side of taller lamp. Outer paper on the shades show some slight ripples. The shade on taller one has some permanent damage visible only on the inside.)

Tall one - 48 inches: \$1200

Short one - 35 inches: \$800 **SOLD**





## Copper Coffee Table

Rustic copperplated steel - with weathered patina, hemp, and world bead details

A used table, in good condition, with several unique ideas. The top is slightly dished along the length. The top has an 8" scratch that will be touched up but probably won't completely disappear. However, since the overall finish is a rustic one, it should not matter.

Size: 44" length x 32" depth x 20" height

\$1650 as is. (Original price \$5600.)





**Side Table circa 1990**

Bleached oak with mill marks, copper sheet with verdigris patina  
66" wide x 37" high x 13" deep

Good condition. This showroom sample available for \$1250. (Original price: \$3200.)



### Prairie Gothic Wall Cabinet circa 1990

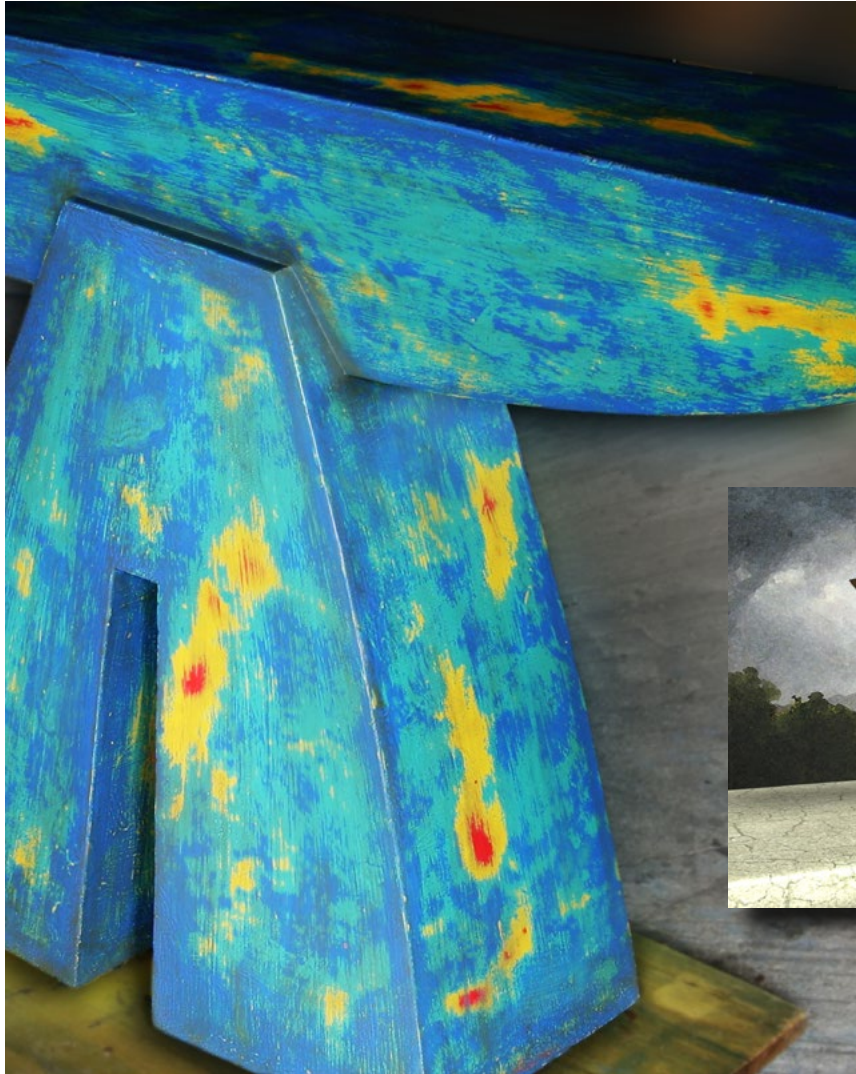
Cherry veneer cabinet with solid walnut doors and carved finger holes

48" wide x 33" tall x 9" deep

Showroom sample

The large photo to the left is of the actual piece and shows the materials and details of this version - with several doors open. Note that the bright colors are only visible when you open the cabinet. I do not have a full picture of this particular one, but the smaller picture of a steel version shows the overall shape accurately with all doors closed. Bronze detail for finger holes. Comes with a cleat for wall hanging.

## Side Table with Fine Art Finish circa 2005

steel with layered enamels  
66" wide x 34" high x 15" deep

This is a steel showroom piece in need of updated finish. The discounted price includes a completely new finish. You'll be consulted on color choices. See smaller image for overall design.

Price with updated finish \$1900 (Original price \$3975)



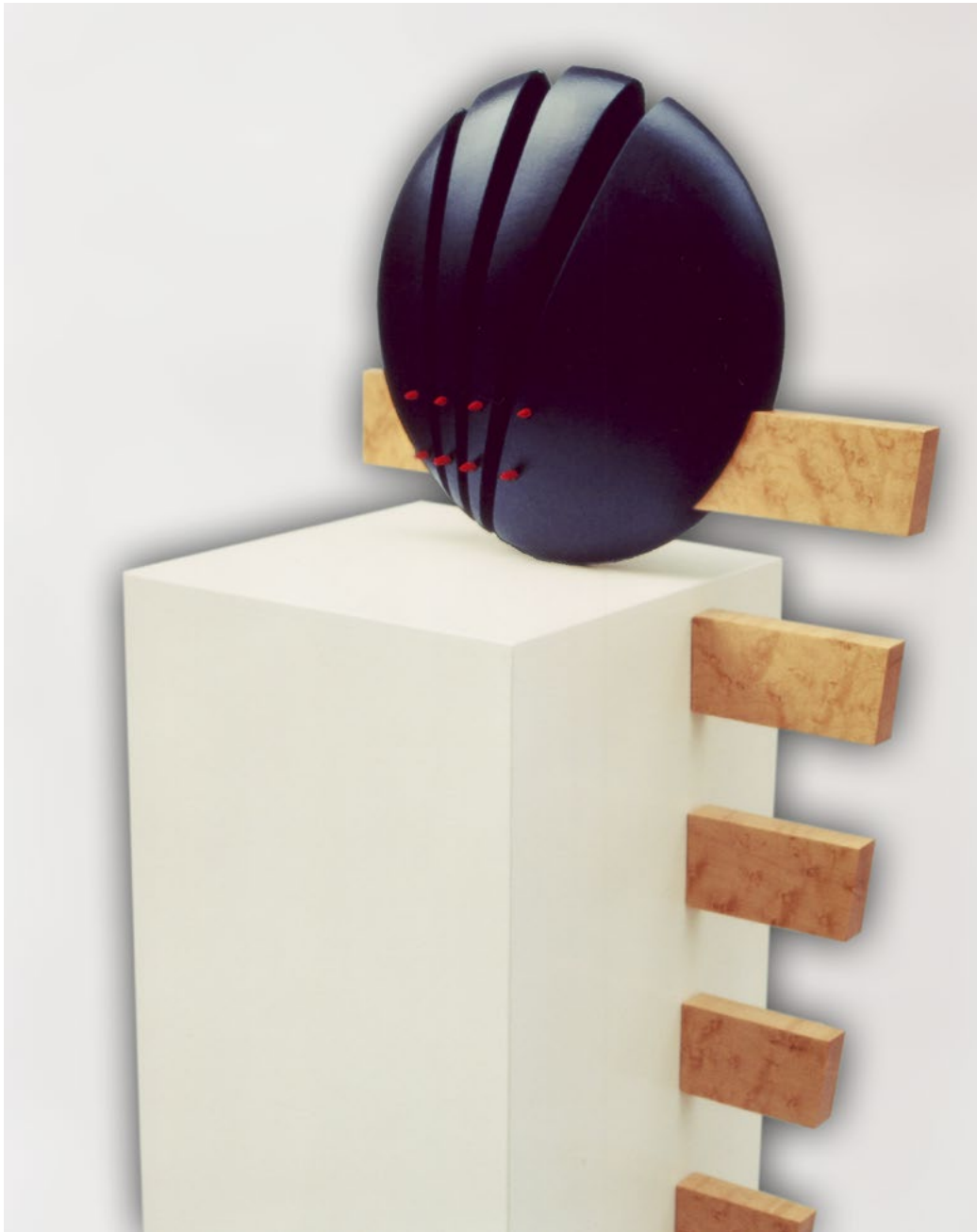
### Abstract Side Table circa 2005

Steel with layered, weathered enamels  
x43" wide x 33" tall x 16" deep

Bright and energetic. Near new condition, showroom piece. (See smaller insert to clarify the innovative form.) For an additional \$600 the color could be changed your specifications. \$1600. (Original price \$3450.)







**Sculpture Title: "Dark Blossom"**  
circa 1990

Wood, MDF, & steel with natural and enamel finishes, integral white pedestal

rough dimensions:  
10" x 16" x 58"

This picture was taken when the piece was new. The birds-eye maple has darkened somewhat, but still lovely. This price will include a restoration to good condition.

## Sculpture Title: "Prairie Drifter II" circa 2010

1/2" steel plate with oxide and enamel patina

dimensions without pedestal: 64"high x 14.5"wide x 1.5" deep  
(7"deep at base).

A heavy steel sculpture for indoor or outdoor use.  
It has been displayed outside my studio and color is about the same as shown here to the right. Digital rendering below without full patina treatment. Good, used condition. Needs no work. Signed and dated. Pedestal shown to the right may be available for indoor display adding 12" to height.

### Sculpture Titles: “Dancer”, “Searcher”, & “Maker” (left to right)

Approximately 47” high about 14” wide each  
1/4” steel plate - currently in an unfinished state requiring finish or patina-  
tion. Shown here with an antique nickel finish.

Gently curved, expressionistic forms that hang slightly away from the wall. Suitable for indoor or outdoor wall display. I generally suggest hanging them about 20” off the floor, putting them about 6’ high.

These are available as a group: In this case, the price includes your choice of an antique nickel finish or an oxide - which will render the condition like new. Other finishes possible at additional cost.

4 table top sculptures in mixed media - primarily Australian lacewood

Good, showroom condition with crate. Will not split set.

### Sculpture titled "Mobile #8101"

1/8" steel, with oxide finish

27" high x16" wide x 9" deep

Indoor/outdoor mobile. Good, showroom condition.

### 3 Bronze Pedestals

These three bronze pedestals circa 2003 were made for a Chicago law office, and became available when they moved. The above picture shows the pieces when I first built them. They have darkened somewhat - but can be buffed up if you desire. There are two pedestals 28" high that can be used separately or together with a glass top to make a dining table or desk - glass not included). And one pedestal 21" that could be used with or without glass - not included).

Price includes cleaning: \$1200 per pedestal (original price \$3900 each)  
Will sell separately.



## Aegean Coffee Table

15" high (x 48" diameter glass - not included)  
copperplate over steel with steel legs

The upper photo was taken when new. The base has darkened somewhat with time. Price will include cleaning and touch up. Glass should be ordered locally and I expect would cost about \$300 for 1/2".

Price for base: \$2200 (original price \$5700)
